The Legal Aid Society of ICFAI Law School, IFHE, Hyderabad, organized a legal awareness program focusing on the right against exploitation. This event was held in collaboration with the District Legal Services Authority (DLSA) of Medak District and the Naari Mani Collective, an NGO dedicated to women's welfare and the well-being of girl children. The program took place on Monday, April 20, 2026, in Jhansi Lingapur village, located in Ramayampet Mandal, Medak District.

Attendees included Sri S. Karunakar, the Chief Legal Aid Defense Counsel from the DLSA, and Mr. Ramakrishna, the Sarpanch of Jhansi Lingapur Village. The primary goal of these programs is to educate rural communities about their rights against forced labor, human trafficking, and child labor.

During the event, the Chief Legal Aid Counsel delivered a speech that highlighted several key areas, including the Abolition of Trafficking (as outlined in Article 23 of the Constitution), the protection of citizens from being sold for any purpose, and the rights of unorganized workers. He emphasized the importance of raising awareness regarding minimum wage rights and social

security benefits for farming and daily-wage workers. Additionally, he provided information on the free legal aid services available at the DLSA office in Medak and stressed the importance of the NALSA Helpline number 15100 for legal advice and assistance.

A poster exhibition titled “Right to Protection from Harassment” was successfully organized. This exhibition aimed to raise awareness about bonded labor and the sexual harassment of women. The posters, which were based on Article 23 of the Constitution of India, the Bonded Labour Abolition Act of 1976, and the POSH Act of 2013, presented the rights of individuals in an accessible manner. The event conveyed a powerful message: awareness of the law is true power.

Interactive game activities conducted by legal aid members assessed participants' understanding of child labor, the sexual exploitation of women, and the abolition of bonded labor. The attendees expressed their appreciation for the efforts of the Legal Aid Society in organizing this important event on fundamental rights. The pamphlet that details the Right against exploitation was distributed to the participants in the Telugu language. This resource aimed to enhance understanding and awareness of the rights and protections available to the community.

The event was funded by the IFHE management under the guidance of Prof. Ravisekara Raju, Director, and Prof. Y.Pratap Reddy, Dean of ICFAI Law School, Hyderabad to promote legal awareness in Telangana. It was coordinated by Dr. S. Kannan, Coordinator of the Legal Aid Society, along with the legal aid members of ICFAI Law School, Hyderabad.
