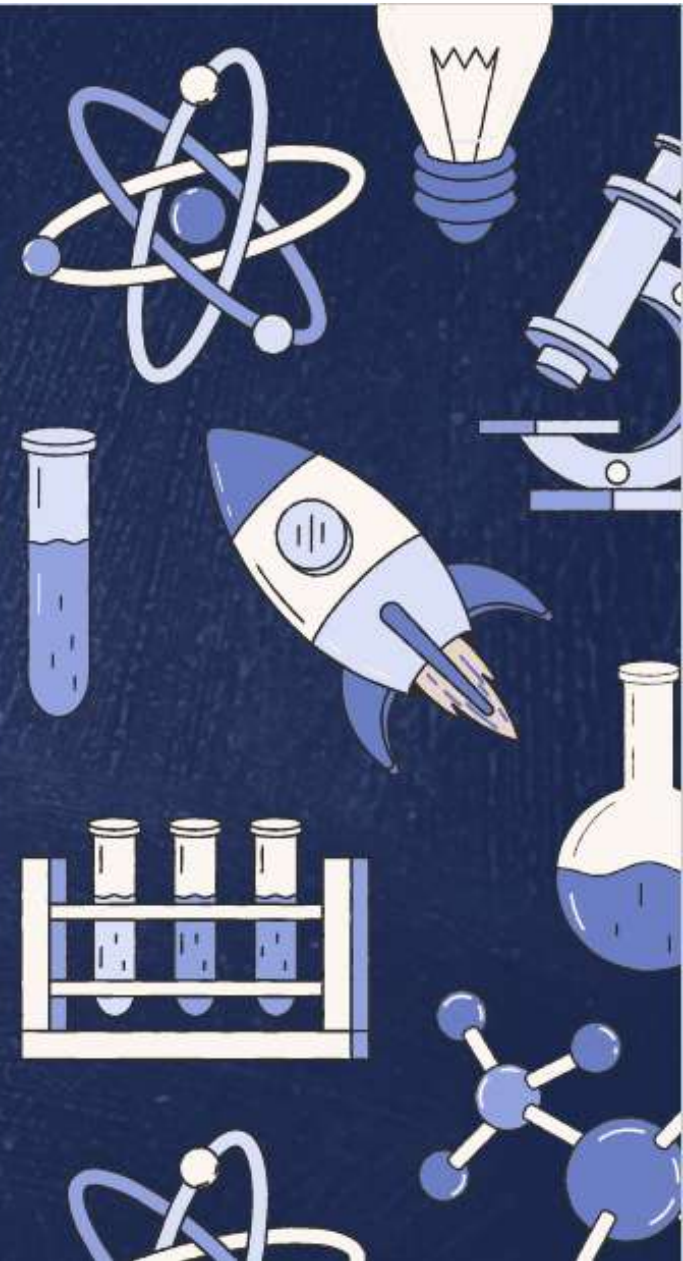
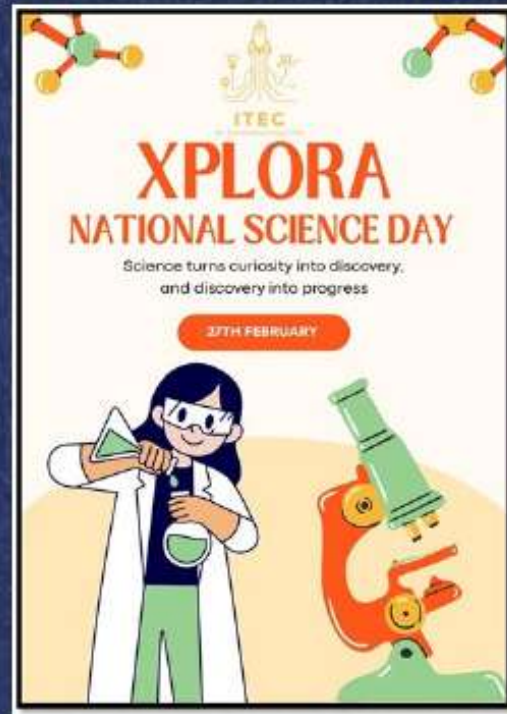

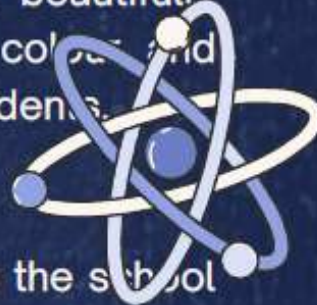
3. Distribution of Books and Stationery
