


Welcome All!

# Client Counselling

The Client Counseling competition mainly addresses fundamental skills which are necessary for all successful attorneys. Competitors conduct an initial interview with a person playing the role of the client. They develop the skills such as the ability to interview, counsel, and support a client through their legal issue as well as non-legal issues. The Competition's main objective is to promote greater knowledge and interest among law students in the preventive law and counseling functions of law practice. It also encourages students to develop interviewing, planning, and analytical skills in the lawyer-client relationship in the law office.

## General Rules and Format

- 1.The maximum number of Participants per team shall be restricted to 2.
- 2.Only ONE Team is allowed per Institution / University.
- 3.Each team will undergo two preliminary rounds where an average of their scores for the two rounds will be tallied and the top 6 teams or 8 teams will break in to the semi-final rounds.
- 4.After the semi-final rounds, only two or three teams will break into the finals.
- 5.The problems shall be broadly based on but not completely limited to the laws and participants are expected to have knowledge of any other ancillary laws and procedures.
6. Participants shall not reveal the identity of his / her college / university at any point of time during the competition.

## General Rules and Format

1. Each team shall consist of three students- Advocate, Client and Mediator.
- 2.The competition seeks to simulate a bipartite mediation between teams based on some common facts and different confidential information privy to each side.

Each round shall be divided into four segments, i.e. (a) Opening Statement of Co-Mediators (b) Opening Statement of Advocate-Client Team (c) Caucuses and Conferences (Co-Mediators have the discretion) (d) Closing Statement of co-Mediators.

- 6) The photographs submitted by the participants shall be displayed in an exhibition that is going to be held in the campus. A panel will decide the winners of the competition at the exhibition.

- V) Each team should comprise of minimum 3 and maximum 8 members.
- vi) Judgement will be based on choreography, rhythms, taal, synchronization, costume, Make-up and overall performance of the group.

## General Rules for all the Competitions

1. All the competitions will be offline.
2. The Competition will be held into two rounds: i) Semi-finals and ii) Finals
3. The participants shall submit their photos along with their application.
4. Participants should be in formal attire for all the competitions and shall mandatorily carry their college identity card for the purpose of identification during the said competition.
5. The IFHE campus is a strictly No-smoking, and No-Alcohol campus, and we expect the participants to strictly follow the same during their stay.
6. Our university believes and promotes the “Swachh Bharat” Campaign and the participants are expected to maintain the cleanliness of the Campus at all times.

11. Once the registration amount is paid by the participants, and the participants intend to withdraw from the said competition or are unable to participate in the competition, the organizing University shall have the sole discretion to refund the registration fee after due consideration.
12. The organizing university is not responsible to make any changes in the schedule of the competition in case a student is participating in more than one competition, in the event of a clash. The participant will have to choose either of the events in such a scenario.
