Labour Cards for Construction Workers

The Legal Aid Society of ICFAI Law School, IFHE, Hyderabad, in collaboration with the Mandal Legal Services Authority, Ranga Reddy District, and ANKITA NGO, launched a drive for labour card registration for construction workers on November 7, 2024. The initiative operates under the Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996, which entitles registered workers to various welfare benefits through the Telangana Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board.

The labour card provides access to benefits such as marriage assistance, maternity benefits, relief for fatal accidents and disabilities (both total and partial), natural death relief, hospitalization assistance, funeral expenses, skill development training, vocational training for dependents, support for unregistered workers, and disability aids and appliances.

Members of the Legal Aid Society educated workers on these social security benefits and assisted them with completing Form 27 for registration and biometric verification. The drive, continuing on November 8 and 9, 2024, requires a ?110 application fee per worker, with ?120 of the total cost sponsored by the ICFAI Law School Alumni Association (Batch of 2024). The event was coordinated by Dr. S. Kannan and the committed members of the Legal Aid Society, ICFAI Law School, IFHE, Hyderabad.

Protection of the Senior Citizens' Rights
