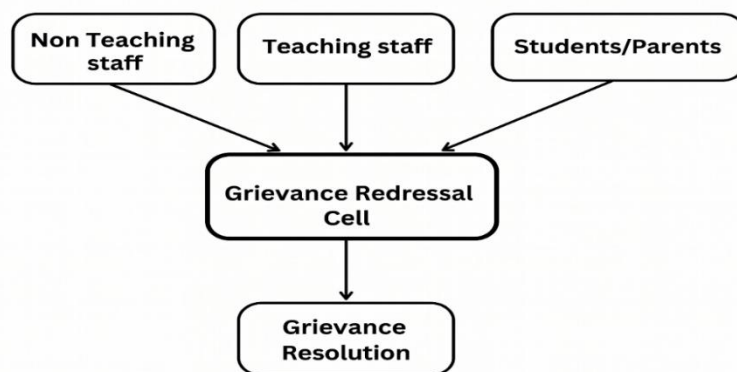
18.5.1 Grievance Redressal Mechanism for Faculty, Staff and Students
