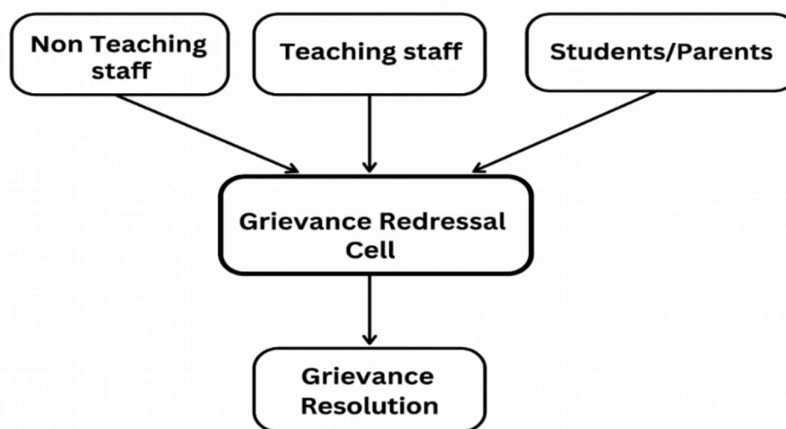
18.5.1 Grievance Redressal Mechanism for Faculty, Staff and Students

Candidates not meeting the eligibility criteria of English medium in graduation have to submit the TOEFL/ NELT/ IELTS score.	The admission is based on IBSAT a Computer Based Test (CBT) and consists of multiple choice questions. IBSAT is of 2 hours' duration and is aimed at testing the applicant's ability in quantitative techniques, data interpretation, data adequacy, vocabulary, analytical reasoning and reading comprehension. The Test is conducted in over 100 test centres across the country. CAT/ GMAT / NMAT GMAT, NMAT and CAT scores are also accepted in lieu of IBSAT.	Candidates who have qualified based on IBSAT / GMAT /NMAT / CAT score are called for the selection process at IFHE Hyderabad. The selection process comprises of Group Discussion and Personal Interview. The final selection of students is based on the cumulative scores obtained by each candidate during group discussion and personal interview apart from past academic performance. A merit list is prepared thereafter. The following weightage are allotted to various parameters 1. 40% - Past Academic Record X (10), XII (12) & Graduation (15/16) 2. 30% - Group Discussion 3. 30% - Personal Interview
