

Founder's Profile



Mr. N. J. Yasaswy (1950-2011), founder of the ICFAI Group of educational institutions and a pioneer in promoting higher education in the private sector had a brilliant academic career: B.Com (Andhra University 1969 – First Rank), CA Inter (May 1971 – First Rank), CA Final (May 1973 – First Rank), ICWA Inter (July 1970 – First Rank) and ICWA Final (July 1972 – First Rank). He was the recipient of the Basu Foundation Award for the Best Student of the Year from both – The Institute of Cost and Works Accountants of India (in 1972) and The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (in 1973).

During 1974-1980, Mr. Yasaswy was associated with the Administrative Staff College of India as a Faculty Member. In 1981, he started his consultancy firm, Yasaswy Management Associates. Hyderabad.

Mr. Yasaswy was appointed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh as Chairman, Andhra Pradesh State Trading Corporation (1985–88), and Vice-Chairman, Public Enterprises Management Board (1986–88). He was a visiting faculty member at the Indian Institute of Management-Ahmedabad (1986-88) and was nominated as a Member on the SEBI Committee on Accounting Standards. He was a member of the Board of Directors of the Association of Certified International Investment Analysts (ACIIA), Switzerland. He authored several books on finance and investments.

Mr. Yasaswy set up the ICFAI as a single institute in 1985 without governmental sops or institutional funding, in an era where government support was the norm. He chose to spend all his energy on the fledgling institution which over the years grew to become a monument to what ambition can deliver. He was instrumental in building several business schools and universities in the developing states of India, particularly in the North-East region. He stood for professional management, excellence in the quality of education offered in the ICFAI institutions, and absolute discipline.

He was charismatic, a great teacher, an institution builder, a visionary and a genius who was years ahead of his time. His vision will continue to quide ICFAI forever.





The BBA Program

The world of business is undergoing rapid transformation due to rapid technological changes. This tectonic shift, popularly termed as Industry 4.0 will witness rapid transformation of the economic, social and technological landscape. Businesses will be forced to alter their manufacturing, procurement, supply chains, distribution and service operations in a very big way and reconfigure their business models. These changes will lead to a spiraling demanding for qualified manpower that is not easily available. A report by leading consulting organization McKinsey predicts that by the year 2030 more than 20 to 50 million jobs will be created worldwide as a result of Industry 4.0



Considering the changes taking place, IBS Bengaluru, a pioneer in management education offers

BBA (Hons.)
(Artificial Intelligence & Data Science)
4 years (with and without research)

These programs are uniquely designed to equip students desirous of pursuing careers in technology and management oriented roles. Students will gain required knowledge and skills in areas such as data science, data analysis, data visualization, data driven decision making, management reporting and operating in virtual environments. Students get the best inputs – Technology and Management.

IBS has modeled and aligned its Undergraduate programs with the New Education Policy 2020 guidelines suggested by the University Grants Commission, Govt of India. It is offering these programs based on a flexible structure. Students have the opportunity to pursue a four year honors program and a four year honors with research program. Those desirous of completing their education at the UG level in three years will be eligible for a three-year degree. In all the programs students have to meet the prescribed criteria for graduating. Students pursuing the four year with or without research can look forward to careers in different management and technology domains as well as go on for higher studies in India and abroad including PhD, in top-rated institutions in India and abroad.

Duration: 3 years / 4 years (with and without research)

Eligibility: Pass in Class XII or equivalent examination with an aggregate of 50% and above marks (any discipline) with English as medium of instruction.

Selection Process: The Selection is based on merit and personal interview. The applicant should fulfil the minimum age requirement as prescribed by the respective board through which the applicant has appeared for the qualifying examination.

BBA (Hons.) (Artificial Intelligence & Data Science) 4 years (with and without research)

Program Structure

The 4-year Program, with option to exit after three years, consists of core management courses (including electives) courses in Al & Data Science, inter-disciplinary courses, Ability Enhancement courses and Value Added Courses.

Students undertake an internship program for a period of 8 weeks in summer term after the second year to provide adequate corporate exposure.

On completion of third year of BBA, the program gives a choice to the students to opt to pursue fourth year for Honour's Degree, with Research Project in Management Studies that concludes with submission of Dissertation. Such students will be awarded BBA (Honours with Research).



Teaching & Learning



The learning at **ICFAI** Law School is multi-dimensional in addition to classroom teaching. A host of activities like Assignments, **Moot Courts, Clinical** Courses, Legal Aids, Immersion Workshops, Seminars/Workshops, Internships, Extracurricular Activities etc., are designed to sharpen the domain knowledge of legal profession.

The ICFAI Law School has a unique and innovative approach to legal education that focuses on providing the right knowledge and skills for enduring success in legal careers. As practice precedes theory, more emphasis is placed on the conceptual understanding and application of law. Learning at ICFAI Law School aims to sharpen the professional skills, organizing skills, interpersonal skills and practical learning of a student, through various learning tools like clinical courses, internships, legal aid clinics and court visits.

Internships: The internships form an important component of law education at ICFAI Law School. It is an attempt to bridge the gap between the professional world and academic institutions. Internship introduces students to reallife situations. Students are encouraged to take up assignments, which are multi-disciplinary, goal-oriented, time bound and involve teamwork. Students of BBA-LLB (Hons.) Program undertake the internship program at the end of each year during the summer holidays. The students are sent to the law firms, corporates, advocates, offices of judges of the High Courts and Supreme Court, NGOs, Consumer Courts, etc., to gain practical knowledge.

Student Centric Approach: The ICFAI Law School has student centric approach in designing the curriculum

of its five years integrated law programs. The programs are blend of theory and practice with an option for student to select the electives of their choice among the alternatives. Thus, it prompts the student to select the courses of their choices from a pool of courses of business laws, constitutional law, international law, intellectual property laws and other law courses and management courses. It offers few courses in foreign languages to make the student flexible to undertake work/ practice belonging to that country. These selected courses provides the extended skill-sets and advanced knowledge base. Professional enhancement courses like legal drafting, ADR Clinics, Legal Aid Projects are compulsory courses which enhance lawyering and advocacy skill sets.

Self-Study/Seminar Courses:

The ICFAI Law School is offering Self-study and Seminar courses to its students. Every student, in addition to the regular courses of the program, may opt for one or two Self study courses during a semester which are Non-Letter Graded courses. The Student during his/her tenure in the law school, may elect one or two courses from the list of the courses provided by the law school. There will not be any regular class work for the said courses. However, a Faculty will be allocated for the courses, the student may consult the said faculty for guidance for completing the course. The

student is required to give two seminar presentations for the course to a panel of experts for evaluation of the study of the course and for allotting the Non-Letter Grade to the students which will be reflected on the Grade Sheet issued by the University.

The Self study /Seminar Course help the students for better credits, augmentation of the focused and specialized knowledge, helps in self learning process which is a core skill for a accomplished lawyers. Students also can exercise the independent thinking ability which is very important in study. Self study activity is more effective than the teaching by others. Self-study and Seminar courses enrich the students research skills, understanding and assimilating the subject matter, and sharpens the presentation skills.

The students are taken to various courts like High Court, Civil Court, Criminal Court, Family Court and Tribunals, accompanied by the Faculty to enable them to observe the proceedings in the court to learn the court craft and practical part of the legal education.




