RULES FOR THE COMPETITION

- 1. There will be four rounds, the **preliminary rounds** (first and second), semi-finals and finals. The first two preliminary rounds will be based on Problem 1 and Semi-finals and Finals based are on Problem 2.
- 2. During the preliminary rounds (first and second) each team shall argue once for the appellant and next for respondent.
- 3. Based upon the merit of aggregate marks of preliminary rounds, eight teams will be selected for the second round.
- 4. Eight teams in the second round will be competing on knockout basis, four teams will be qualified for semi-finals.
- 5. Semi-final round will be knockout round, two teams from 9. The Moot problems are attached along with this it qualifies for final.
